

# **MEDICATION RETURN BOX**

Unused medications can be a threat to you and your family if they fall into the wrong hands. Dublin Borough Police participate in the Spring and Fall National Drug Take Back Events and can be found on those event days at the Dublin Fire House from the hours of 10:00 AM to 2:00 PM. But those events only come twice a year. If you have prescription medications to discard at other times, the Drug Meds Return Box is located in the lobby of Borough Hall. The box is accessible any time that Borough Hall is open for business and is a handy and safe place to dispose of your unwanted prescription drugs. For those that cannot make it in during normal business hours please contact Bucks County Radio at 215-328-8501 to have an officer meet you at the station and give you access to the Drug Meds Return Box.



# **UPDATES FOR THE 143RD LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT**

It continues to be an honor to represent the residents of the 143rd Legislative District. As we are several months into the current legislative session, I wanted to take a moment to provide you with an update on an important piece of legislation as well as how my office can be of assistance to you.

The House recently passed an expansion of the Property Tax and Rent Rebate program for both homeowners and renters which was signed into law as Act 7 of 2023. The expansion has increased the income limit to \$45,000 dollars for both homeowners and renters as well as increased the maximum rebate from \$650 to \$1,000. This change will take effect starting next year. The program is for all Pennsylvania residents 65 years or older, widows or widowers 50 years or older, and individuals with disabilities 18 years or older. If you have any questions about this expansion or assistance with applying, please don't hesitate to contact my office.

My Office is located at the Silo Hill Professional Building, 1032 N. Easton Road in Plumstead Township. I also offer satellite office hours every Friday from 9:00 am to 12:00 pm at the Silverdale Municipal Building located at 100 Park Avenue in Silverdale Borough. Please contact my office at 215-489-2126 or RepShelbyLabs.net/contact to share your thoughts and concerns, or for assistance with any state

related matter. My offices can help with PennDOT paperwork, SEPTA Key Senior Fare Card Applications (originals and renewals), Birth Certificates Applications, Property Tax and Rent Rebate Applications, state tax forms, and much more. # PRIVATE LATERAL INSPECTIONS CONTINUE

In 2003 Dublin Borough adopted Ordinance # 248 - An Ordinance Prohibiting the Discharge of Stormwater, Surface Water, Groundwater, Roof Run-Off, or Sub-Surface Drainage in the Public Sanitary Sewer System. In order to enforce this ordinance, the Borough established a program to determine sources of excess water entering the sanitary sewer system from private property laterals and building piping. This excessive clear water is a major problem for our pipeline and treatment systems during wet weather. It is possible that your property may be discharging such

water through roof drains, foundations, and/or sump pumps. The discharge of any of these sources into the public sanitary sewer is a violation of both state and local regulations.

Please be advised, staff has reached out to residents to schedule an on-site inspection of the home to ensure that all properties within the Borough comply with the above ordinance. We have almost completed the properties for this year and will continue doing approximately 100 properties per year. We appreciate your cooperation as we work through completing these inspections.

### BE READY FOR HARSH WEATHER



Inspect your home by removing leaves and trash from gutters and storm drains. During the winter, remove ice and snow near drains and downspouts. Clear snow around the foundation of your house before it melts. Secure your windows and doors. If you have a sump pump, check it to make sure it works.

If water gets into your home, try to keep the water away from outlets and other electrical sources. Turn off your main electrical switch while standing on a rubber mat or dry wood.

Be aware, if the water rises high enough to put out the pilot light on the water heater or furnace, it may let out gas. Turn off the gas to these units. Don't use candles, lanterns, or open flames around them until you are certain that nothing is leaking gas.

If water rises before you leave your house, get to a higher floor. Do not try to swim to safety, wait for rescuers to come to you.

When the storm is over, wait for the water to drain out of the property, check for structural damage before re-entering the property. Don't use any kind of flame, since explosive gas may still be trapped inside. Keep the power off until an electrician has inspected the system.

#### **BURNING IN THE BOROUGH**

Please do not push leaves into the street, you can bag them in brown paper bags and put them out on the last Saturday of the month for yard waste collection.

Per section 20-104 of the Borough Code "It shall be unlawful for any person to burn any residential or multi-residential waste, leaf waste, or source-separated recyclable materials, excluding wood/coal stoves, charcoal pits and BBQ fires for pleasure."





# **HOUSE NUMBERS**

When an emergency happens, every second counts. You don't want those seconds to be spent by emergency responders trying to find your house because you haven't properly displayed your address outside your home. In order to ensure your house number is visible from the roadway

frequently trim any bushes, weeds, flowers, or grass away from your signs so that all numbers are clearly visible. If you have hanging flowers, flags, or other items on your porch that block your 9-1-1 address numbers from being seen quickly by responders, please relocate them.




