Reference: *Sanitary Sewer Mainline, Lateral and Manhole Relining*

Dear Resident:

This letter shall serve as notice that Dublin Borough has awarded a Contract pertaining to the flushing, cleaning and lining of approximately 2,185 linear feet of 8", 10" and 12" sanitary sewer main on Elephant Road and within easement areas between High Street and Deep Run Road and between Deep Run Road and Elephant Road. The work also includes the lining of 16 manholes. The work will be performed by Standard Pipe Services of Newark, DE. The work on this project is scheduled to commence on Tuesday, February 21, 2023. The work is expected to be completed by the end of March, weather permitting. The contractor will be responsible for the restoration of any lawn damage that may result from accessing the easement areas. Prior to the sanitary sewer main relining work, the contractor will notify you that you should minimize your water usage while they are working on the sewer main to which your lateral is connected, as there will be a short time that your sewer lateral is closed off. Once the liner has cured (about 2-4 hours after the liner is installed), the lateral will be reinstated (opened).

The purpose of the work on this project is to reduce the effects of Infiltration/Inflow into the Borough's sanitary sewer conveyance system in accordance with a PADEP Consent Order. The sewers on this project have been identified through previous internal televised inspections as having defects that require rehabilitation. The liner system is a much less intrusive and more cost-effective alternative to open trench excavation and removal/replacement of the sewer mains.
