

PROCLAMATION OF WINTER STORM EMERGENCY  
FEBRUARY 22, 2021 AT 8:00 AM THROUGH  
FEBRUARY 22, 2021 AT 8:00 PM

Chief Michael Regan has declared a Winter Storm Emergency for the Dublin Borough effective Monday, February 22nd at 8:00 AM through Friday, February 22nd at 8:00 PM for the duration of the winter storm or until snow and ice has been cleared from public streets.

Please remove all vehicles from public streets and avoid unnecessary travel. Vehicles parked on posted snow emergency routes will be ticketed and may be towed.

In addition, Chief Regan reminds property owners that Dublin Borough Ordinance # 121 requires that ALL sidewalks be cleared of snow and ice within 24 hours after the precipitation has ended. Failure to clear sidewalks could result in citations being issued. This is for the safety and well-being of the public using the sidewalks and prevents pedestrians from entering the roadways.
